- **Nursery: 9:00am | Year-Round (birth up to 4K)** We offer nursery for newborns up through kids going in 4K so that parents can give their full attention to the worship service.
- **Sunday School: 9:00am | School Year (4K-5th grade)**

- **BLAST: Wednesday Evenings | School Year (4K-5th grade) 5:45-7:30pm**
Our BLAST program is a fun-filled evening for kids including games, music, and opportunities to build friendships.
